All temporary agencies have been asked to keep a log of applicant correspondences. A tentative deadline of September 9th has been placed to contact all applicants. The deadline date is posted on our website to advise applicants.
- All ballot information has been forwarded to the SOS CES ballot builder, we are awaiting completion of the ballot project

Key Activities:

Application Solution

- ***EasyVote Update:*** The vendor released an updated version of the EasyVote application on August 29, 2022. We are currently testing the updated version and will proceed with installing the updated version on laptops.
- ***Outlook Update:*** The team have been working with the Advance Voting staff to ensure all compliance officer, Poll Managers, Assistant Poll manager and Poll Clerks have an active Fulton County account and Outlook Web Access.
- ***Project Manager Update:*** The November 08, 2022, General election project was completed.
- ***Poll Worker Platform:*** The department is working with a vendor to build a Poll Worker Module and application that will provide a single platform that supports
 - Poll Worker Registration and Approval
 - Poll Worker training and Assessment
 - Poll worker precinct assignment
 - Election staff communicate to Poll managers/Workers through chat
 - Poll Manager communication to election staff during the Advance Voting/ Election Day

We plan on Implementing a pilot program in January 2023.

Warehouse

- ***Philip Lee Warehouse:*** The team worked with the D.R.E.A.M and I.T departments to install power drops, surveillance, and Access Points.
- ***Election Central:*** The team attended weekly meetings with D.R.E.A.M Department on general construction progress and worked with the I.T department to provide audio-visual requirements for the board room, training room, collaboration rooms and break room.

Voting Equipment

System specialists completed the post-election procedure on the voting equipment, and equipment with issues was shipped to the vendor for repairs. System Specialists are getting ready to be re-trained in WDS inventory System and the Logic and Accuracy Procedures.

VOTER REGISTRATION

The total number of voter registration applications we received in 2022 is **120,085**. This number includes voter registration applications received via the Department of Driver Services, the Online Voter Registration portal with the Secretary of State's Office, applications from 3rd party vendors, and applications mailed or dropped off at our office.

As of August 31, 2022, there were **845,489** (**730,898** active and **114,591** inactive) registered voters residing in Fulton County.

National Vote Early Day will be a weekend push for advance voting across all cities within Fulton County, working with organizations and municipalities to spread the word.

The VEO team has reached out to all the colleges and universities within the county and will be hosting a variety of events with them in September to ensure the students are educated about the upcoming election and pushing to recruit students to serve as poll workers for the November election.

The VEO created a Voter Education and Outreach kit for the County Manager and the Fulton County Commissioners and delivered the information to their offices so they could share it with their constituents. In September, the team will also create kits for all the Fulton county libraries to have the most up-to-date voter information. The VEO Manager will also send updated information to all the organizations and contacts in the VEO database.

The VEO team is continuously planning events and will continue contacting schools, communities, non-profit organizations, and government officials to schedule future events across the county.
