**Chairperson Cooney entertained a motion to approve the eleven sites listed with the additions of Chastain Park Gym and Welcome All Recreation Center. The motion was made by Mr. Burge, seconded by Mr. Johnson and carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.**

Alpharetta Branch Library, Buckhead Library, Chastain Park Gym, College Park Library, C.T. Martin Natatorium Recreation Center, East Roswell Branch Library, Fulton County Government Center, Milton Library, North Fulton Service Center (Room 232), Ponce De Leon Library, Robert F. Fulton Ocee Library, South Fulton Service Center, Southwest Art Center, Wolf Creek Library, Welcome All Recreation Center.

**Chairperson Cooney entertained a motion to reconsider the approval of thirteen early voting locations with the additions of Milton Library and Southwest Art Center. The motion was made by Mr. Wingate, seconded by Mr. Burge and carried by a unanimous vote of 5-0.**
