#1 – APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Vice Chairperson Wingate entertained a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Dr. Ruth and carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.

#2-COMMUNICATIONS AND PUBLIC RESPONSE

Vice Chairperson Wingate entertained a motion to waive the normal rules to allow additional public comments after the meeting started. The motion was made by Ms. Nuriddin, seconded by Mr. Johnson and carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.
