INFORMATION SYSTEMS DIVISION

KEY ACTIVITIES:

Application Solution

- WDS inventory System: We tested and moved two modules into the production environment.
- 1. *QA module:* The QA module will validate the asset and seal assigned during Logic and Accuracy.
- 2. *Field OPS Management:* The module manages the truck inventory, damages, and assignment. Also, the System Specialist will use the module to report, and hot swap damaged equipment while performing technician rover duties on election day.

Voting Equipment

System specialists started Logic and Accuracy on the voting equipment in preparation for the November 08, 2022, General Election.

- *Early Voting Logic and Accuracy:* We tested and deployed 408 BMDs, 79 ICP scanners and 242 Poll Pads. Logic and Accuracy was carried out in accordance with the SOS guidelines and each scanner been deployed was tested with every type ballot style and activation code that exist in the November 08, 2022 election project. We simulated the voting experience and machine patterns during the logic and Accuracy.
 1. All precinct in Fulton county is present on every scanner (No separate scanner for cities or County)
 2. The average ballot scan time for a FED ballot was between 9 – 15 seconds and the average scan time for a Non-Partisan ballot was between 15 – 28 seconds.
 3. Daily start-up time increases with scanner count represented in the table below

Training

Poll Technician Training: Early Voting Poll Technician training is scheduled for **Monday, 10/03**, at the Election Preparation Center training room. The team have been working with the Early Voting staff to compile a user guide for the technician in areas where most locations have reported issues in the past elections. Also, we are working with the agency task with election day poll technician recruitment to give insight into the type of applicant we are looking for and their duties.

Information System Division held a meeting with the other division managers to discuss better and improve how to protect Personal Identifiable Information in their care.

- Permission will be restricted on Cognito for seasonal workers, and only managers will have access to applications.
- Managers will be trained to retract **ANY** Personal Identifiable Information on a report before sending it to staff.
- Sharing applicant reports with trusted outside vendors **MUST** be through a secure sharedfile link.

REGISTRATION DIVISION

This Monthly Report provides a summary of the critical registration activities, workload levels, and voter registration statistics for the Registration Division of the Fulton County Registration & Elections Department for October 2022. The primary activities the VR staff worked on in September were processing voter registration applications, Redistricting, confirmation notices, researching street issues, municipal street audits, processing registration issues, preparing notices to voter registration applicants, scanning, indexing registration cards, and training.

VOTER REGISTRATION

The total number of voter registration applications we received in 2022 is **137,674**. This number includes voter registration applications received via the Department of Driver Services, the Online Voter Registration portal with the Secretary of State's Office, applications from 3rd party vendors, and applications mailed or dropped off at our office.

As of September 30, 2022, there were **854,463** (**743,327** active and **111,136** inactive) registered voters residing in Fulton County.

In September, The Voter Education and Outreach team focused on civic engagement holidays and outreach to senior centers, colleges, universities, and municipalities. The VEO manager continued working with the Fulton County high schools to conduct Deputy Registrar training for the administrators and staff. The VEO team also worked to train Deputy Registrars across the county to help implement a successful National Voter Registration Day, hosting 16 events across the county.

The Voter Education and Outreach Team also successfully coordinated 16 events for Disability Voter Rights Week 2022- September 12-16, 2022.

The VEO team also hosted Municipal Poll worker Recruitment Fairs in Johns Creek, Milton, Sandy Springs, Roswell, Atlanta, and Alpharetta. Ensuring the residents in those cities who wanted to work the polls could sign up for advance voting and election day.

Since the Voter Registration deadline is coming up on October 11, we worked with all the colleges and universities within the county to train deputy registrars and host events on campus every week until the deadline.

For October, we are focusing on implementing National Voter Education Week and National Vote Early Day. We will be pushing organizations, civic groups, fraternities, and sororities to take advantage of voting on the last weekend. We will also partner with the Carter Center to host an on-site National Voter Early event during the October 28-30 weekend.
